↑ **1** In the centre of Moffat, put the ram statue on your right, and head downhill, leaving Marchbanks Bakery to your right

↩ **2** Bear left onto the A708 to Selkirk (33 miles)

↘ **3** Turn right at T-junction onto A707 (300 yards)

↘ **4** After crossing the river, take the first right into Ettrick Road (300 yards)

↑ **5** Follow Ettrick Road, soon the B7009/B709 to Eskdalemuir (30 miles)

↘ **6** At the church, turn right onto B723 to Boreland (7 miles)

↘ **7** Soon after the village, turn right, signed Moffat, to T-junction (5 miles). *(If you prefer to avoid the narrow, potholed, final section to Moffat, don't turn right after Boreland, but continue on the B723 (ignoring the left turn to Lockerbie) until the tall chimney of Steven's Croft power station is on your right. Turn left, then right onto the 'service road' towards Beattock, until you pick up signs to Moffat. It's longer but it's a faster road!)*

↘ **8** Turn right and follow the road to T-junction in Moffat (6 miles)

↩ **9** Turn left to return to the town centre (0.5 mile)
